

Glitter Snowflakes

**Remember: These instructions are just guidelines.
You are always encouraged to use your imagination
and make what feels right to you!**

Materials needed:

White paper

Scissors

Glitter paint or glitter glue

Optional– thread or string, 2 craft sticks,
glue



Cut paper snowflakes out of white paper

- To make a snowflake, fold a square piece of paper in half so it forms a triangle.
- Fold in half again so it forms a smaller triangle.
- Arrange your triangle to the closed, pointed tip is at the top.
- Take the left angle and fold over about 2/3 of the way to the other side.
- Then take the right angle and fold it over about 2/3 way to the other side.
- Trim the bottom off of this arrow-like shape so the bottom edges are all even. You should have a sharp triangle.
- Cut different pieces out of each side to get an original snowflake (well aren't all snowflake original?)

Paint your snowflake with glitter glue. If you would like, you can take 2 craft sticks and glue in the shape of an "x". When the "x" is dry, gently tie 4 strands of thread to each end. Then gently tie each end of the thread to a snowflake, to create a snowflake mobile. You may also want to paint or decorate the craft sticks.
